



**Mopar Rebellion Car Club:
Club Bylaws**

Article 1:

Section 1: The official name of the club is *Mopar Rebellion*.

Section 2: The official club logo includes a red '71 Hemicuda on the left, a pentastar with the words "Mopar Rebellion" in the middle, and a green '69 1/2 Super Bee on the right.

Amendment: The logo was updated in January 2001, to reflect the need for a logo, which was unique to Mopar Rebellion. The current club logo consists of a gray ram's head on the left and a bumble bee with an engine on his back on the right. The letters "M" and "R" are incorporated into the logo to represent the club name, Mopar Rebellion. The logo is within a lime green pentastar.

Section 3: All members will adhere to all current Mopar Rebellion bylaws as well as rules concerning specific club events.

Section 4: All members of Mopar Rebellion will receive a copy of the bylaws and are expected to be familiar with its contents.

Article 2: Objectives

Section 1: To promote an awareness, interest, and appreciation in the preservation, restoration, and enjoyment of Chrysler Corporation vehicles.

Section 2: To promote safety in driving and automobile maintenance and operation.

Section 3: To conduct club functions and activities in a manner benefiting all members of Mopar Rebellion as well as other automotive hobbyists.

Section 4: To encourage better understanding of automobiles as a constructive sport among members of the public, press, and law enforcement agencies.

Section 5: To promote interest in various forms of automotive activities and uphold the principles of good government.

Section 6: To create good fellowship and sportsmanship among all members of the club as well as other car clubs and the public in general.

Section 7: Mopar Rebellion is a non-profit organization. The money collected will be used to further the club activities benefiting all members and the public.

Article 3: Membership

Section 1: Membership fee is \$15.00 for the first year and \$10.00 each year thereafter.

Section 2: Dues will be paid each year on the anniversary of the date the member joined. A three month grace period will be given. If the dues are not paid within three months of the due date the member will be required to apply for membership at the initial rate of \$15.00.

Section 3: Obtaining and Sustaining Membership.

- A) Potential members must attend at least one club function before becoming eligible for membership. However, exceptions may be made on a case by case basis for reasons such as employment obligations.
- B) Applicants must be sponsored by a member in good standing.
- C) Members need not own a Chrysler vehicle to join.

Section 4: All immediate family members are included in the membership. An immediate family member may join separately with the payment of annual dues.

Section 5: The Board and Officers retain the right to revoke or deny any membership.

Section 6: A membership quota of 50 members has been established. If the quota is reached in any given year it will be raised the following year by 5 members. After reaching a membership of 50 members, if the incremental quota of 5 additional members is achieved in any given year the quota will be raised the next year by 5 and so on. However, the Board has the right to establish a permanent quota at any time.

Section 7: Immediate family members who wish to become separate members will be exempt from all quotas.

Section 8: Members are expected to act responsibly when participating in automotive activities and club functions.

- A) A first offense of bad conduct merits a warning.
- B) A second offense of bad conduct constitutes a vote by Board Members to decide whether or not to suspend the member.
- C) If the second offense is of the same nature as the first offense, the member may be removed at the discretion of the Board.
- D) Alcoholic beverages are prohibited from all club functions and activities.

Article 4: Officers

- Section 1: There will be four officers as follows: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.
- Section 2: There will be four Board Members.
- Section 3: Nominees for the Board must be active members in good standing who will be able to attend meetings and help conduct meetings if necessary.
- Section 4: Board Members will be elected every two years. Only two Board Members will be elected in any given year.
- Section 5: Officers will be nominated no later than the last meeting of the year before the end of the term for that position. The newly elected officer will take office on the first day of the following year.
- Section 6: Officers will be elected every two years in the following manner: President and Treasurer will be elected during the last month of odd numbered Years. Vice President and Secretary will be elected during the last month of even numbered years. All newly elected Offices will take effect on the first day of the new year following the election.
- Section 7: Elections will be decided by a majority vote of the members present at the meeting during which the election is held.

Article 5: Benefits

- Section 1: All members will receive the following:
- A) Membership card
 - B) Monthly newsletter
 - C) List of all members and officers
 - D) Copy of Bylaws
 - E) Discounts at various businesses and other establishments
- Section 2: All members are strongly encouraged to share their knowledge, ideas, suggestions, and information.
- Section 3: All members will be able to purchase club merchandise such as jackets, T-shirts, hats, stickers and any other items offered for sale with the official club logo.
- Section 4: All members will be welcome and invited to attend any and all club activities and functions, and no member in good standing shall be excluded from any club activity or function.
